Press the **SETTING** button on the motor head for 1 SEC The blind will jog once.

Press the UP button on the remote, the blind will jog once.

At this stage the remote/channel and motor is paired.

#### STEP 4 - CHECK THE ROLLING DIRECTION

Press the UP button on the remote

If the blind moves up, go to STEP 5. If the blind moves down you will need to reverse the rolling direction of the blind:

Press the STOP button on the remote for 5 SEC, the blind will jog once.

Press the DOWN button on the remote, the blind will jog once.

At this point the rolling direction has been changed. Press the **UP** button to ensure the blind moves up.

# SETTING THE LIMITS STEP 5 - SET THE TOP LIMIT

Press the **PROGRAM** button on the back of the remote for 1 SEC The blind will jog once.

Move blind into the open position by pressing the **UP** button, (the movement will be a micro movement)
For continuous movement, press and hold the **UP** button push **STOP** when it is in the required open position and micro adjust if required.

**NB:** Press the **PROGRAM** button on the back of the remote again for 1 SEC The blind will jog once.

The top limit is now set.

(Please note: This top limit can only be deleted by restoring the motor to factory default - STEP 12)

### FOR GROUP CONTROL

Select the channel you want to use for your group.

Press CHANNEL+ or CHANNEL- to choose the channel.

Your chosen channel will illuminate BLUE on the remote channel display.

For this example we will pick CHANNEL 4 as our group channel (BLIND 1, BLIND 2 AND BLIND 3 will operate together on CHANNEL 4)

To program BLIND 1, follow STEP 10 Once complete, power off BLIND 1 (STEP 1)

To program BLIND 2, follow STEP 10 Once complete, power off BLIND 2 (STEP 1)

To program BLIND 3, follow STEP 10

Power on BLIND 1 and 2 (STEP 1)

### **EXAMPLE**

CHANNEL 1 is paired with BLIND 1

CHANNEL 2 is paired with BLIND 2

CHANNEL 3 is paired with BLIND 3

CHANNEL 4 (THE DESIGNATED GROUP CHANNEL) IS PAIRED WITH BLIND 1, BLIND 2 and BLIND 3.

# REMOTE OPERATION

### STEP 8 - EXIT THE LIMIT SETTING MODE BY WAITING 30 SECONDS

Before programming another motor, we recommend powering off the first motor (STEP 1). This will ensure the first motor is not effected by the new programming of the second motor.

# STEP 9 - DELETING A LIMIT SETTING

Move blind into one of your limit settings you wish to delete by pressing the **UP/DOWN** button

(Please note you cannot delete the top limit)

Push and hold the **PROGRAM** button on the remote for 7 SEC The blind jog after 1 SEC and will then jog again after 7 SEC

### STEP 10 - ADDING A CHANNEL/ NEW REMOTE TO YOUR BLIND

Choose a Channel on your remote

Press the **SETTING** button on the motor head for 1 SEC The blind will jog once.

Press the UP button on your remote, the motor will jog

# STEP 11 - DELETE A CHANNEL FROM YOUR BLIND

Choose the Channel you wish to remove on your remote

Press the STOP button on your remote for 5 SEC, the motor will jog

Press the **PROGRAM** button on the back of your remote for 1 SEC The motor will jog.

### STEP 12 - FACTORY RESET YOUR MOTOR

Press the STOP button on your remote for 5 SEC, the motor will jog


Press and hold **PROGRAM** button on the back of your remote for 7 SEC (within 10 SECONDS)

The motor will jog in 1 SEC and then will jog again after 7 SEC

#### PLEASE NOTE

If you have multiple blinds that you wish to program onto one channel You will be required to power off each motor after programming has been completed (STEP 1) and move on to the next motor.

Once all motors have been programmed, power on each motor (STEP 1)

# CHARGING (applicable to Battery motors only)

The MasterVue motor has a built in rechargeable Li-ion battery. Please charge when the motor stops working or when operation begins to slow down. Plug the pin end into the charging cable on the motor head, and then insert the plug into the socket. Charging time is 5 to 6 hours.
